**PLAYER INFORMATION**

**COVID-19 Information**

- By state mandate, players/spectators must wear a mask while inside the clubhouse or pro shop. As long as six-foot social distancing is maintained, there is no mask requirement while outside.

**Schedule**

36-hole stroke play competition, gross scores only.

**Saturday, May 15:** First round starting times from the #1 and #10 tee, from 7:00 A.M. – 9:00 A.M. and 11:45 A.M. – 1:45 P.M.

**Sunday, May 16:** Second round starting times from the #1 and #10 tee, from 7:00 A.M. – 9:00 A.M. and 11:45 A.M. – 1:45 P.M.

***\*2<sup>nd</sup> round pairings will fall in same timeframe as round 1 (all girls 7:00am-8:15am, some boys in morning wave, but most in afternoon wave). 2<sup>nd</sup> round pairings will be done by 1<sup>st</sup> round scores and the 14-15 & 16-18 divisions combined.***

**Estimated Tournament Yardage (see separate attachment for hole-by-hole information)**

Boys 14-18 – ~6600 yards

Girls 14-18 – ~5800 yards

**GOLF SHOP HOURS**

Opens at 6:00 a.m. each day.

**DRIVING RANGE HOURS**

Opens at 6:00 a.m. each day.

Players can purchase range balls inside the Liberty Lake GC pro shop. Liberty Lake will be offering ½ price buckets.

**FOOD SERVICE**

The Liberty Lake restaurant will open at a time to be determined. Final restaurant hours will be emailed out prior to the tournament.

**TIME OF STARTING**

Players must be near their starting tee 10 minutes prior to their tee time. The starter will call your group into the teeing area once they are ready for you.

## **PRACTICE ROUND**

Liberty Lake GC is a public golf course and contestants may play a practice round(s) prior to the tournament. Standard junior rates apply and please call the golf shop at 509-255-6233 to schedule a time.

## **DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES**

Distance measuring devices that conform to the Rules of Golf and measure distance only are permitted for use by **ALL DIVISIONS**. **Please remember that cell phone use is not allowed on the golf course so cell phone app distance measuring devices will not be permitted.**

## **DRESS CODE**

1. **Golf attire for players (volunteers and walking scorers are encouraged to follow the WJGA dress code and to be a role model with regard to their choice of golf course attire):**
2. **PROPER ATTIRE FOR BOYS, GIRLS AND VOLUNTEERS**  
Neat and clean clothing, shoes, sleeves and collars on shirts. Collarless shirts designed for golf are acceptable. All hats must be worn bill forward.

**Boys:** Shirts must be tucked in at all times and pants/shorts must be khaki, cotton or similar traditional golf material.

**Girls:** Shirts and blouses may be either collarless or sleeveless and must be golf-appropriate. No bare midriff showing. Pants, capri pants, shorts, skorts and skirts on girls that are appropriate for golf and worn as the manufacturer intended are acceptable.

### **IMPROPER ATTIRE:**

Athletic shorts, short shorts, tee shirts, tank tops, jeans (denim of any color), cut-offs, sweats, spandex, yoga attire, jeggings, leggings and halter-tops.

**If unable or unwilling to abide by the WJGA Dress Code Policy the player will not be able to play that event.**

## **AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION**

Automotive transportation is prohibited. **Spectator carts are not permitted unless a valid handicap placard or doctor's note is provided.**
