Course Information

Boys will play the Red/Blue Nines Girls will play the Blue/Green Nines

Schedule

18-hole stroke play, gross scores only. Top-16 Boys and Top-16 Girls will go into Match Play Championship Flight, all other players will go into 4-person flights based on 18-hole score.

All ties for flights will be decided by the matching of scorecards per USGA retrogression (back nine score, final 6 holes, final 3 holes, last hole).

Monday, July 26: Stroke Play starting times from the #1 tee, from 7:30 A.M. – 12:33 P.M.

Range tokens may be purchased in the golf shop or at the driving range machine beginning at 6:30am.

FOOD SERVICE

The Eagles Pride Restaurant/Snack Bar will open at 7:30am each day.

TIME OF STARTING

Players must be near the 1st tee 10 minutes prior to their tee time. The starter will call your group into the teeing area once they are ready for you.

PRACTICE ROUND

Eagles Pride GC is a public golf course and contestants may play a practice round(s) prior to the tournament. Standard Eagles Pride GC junior rates apply.

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES

Distance measuring devices that conform to the Rules of Golf and measure distance only are permitted for use by <u>ALL DIVISIONS</u>. Please remember that cell phone use is not allowed on the golf course so cell phone app distance measuring devices will not be permitted.

DRESS CODE

- 1. Golf attire for players (volunteers and walking scorers are encouraged to follow the WJGA dress code and to be a role model with regard to their choice of golf course attire):
- PROPER ATTIRE FOR BOYS, GIRLS AND VOLUNTEERS
 Neat and clean clothing, shoes, sleeves and collars on shirts. Collarless shirts designed for golf are acceptable. All hats must be worn bill forward.

Boys: Shirts must be tucked in at all times and pants/shorts must be khaki, cotton or similar traditional golf material.

Girls: Shirts and blouses may be either collarless or sleeveless and must be golf-appropriate. No bare midriff showing. Pants, capri pants, shorts, skorts and skirts on girls that are appropriate for golf and worn as the manufacturer intended are acceptable.

IMPROPER ATTIRE:

Athletic shorts, short shorts, tee shirts, tank tops, jeans (denim of any color), cut-offs, sweats, spandex, yoga attire, jeggings, leggings and halter-tops.

If unable or unwilling to abide by the WJGA Dress Code Policy the player will not be able to play that event.

AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION

Automotive transportation is prohibited. **Spectator carts are not permitted unless a valid handicap placard or doctor's note is provided.**
